The Trieste Flute Association was established in 2009 on the initiative of the Trieste Flute Ensemble, directed by Giorgio Blasco since its foundation in 2005, in order to spread the knowledge of the flute and the music related to it. The Association proposes the deepening of the study, the enhancement of the knowledge and repertoire of the flute through courses, musical events, exchanges and cultural initiatives.

Trieste Flute Festival

The Trieste Flute Day was born in 2010 from an idea by M° Blasco, founding member and honorary president of the Trieste Flute Association. In recent editions it was developed by President Ettore Michelazzi, and culminated last year with the first Trieste Flute Festival and the great event "2000flauti2000vele", which saw the presence of over a thousand flautists and ten thousand spectators. This year the Trieste Flute Day is at its ninth edition, and is celebrated with the second Trieste Flute Festival, which will see the realization of a series of events like last year: itinerant lessons & concerts dedicated to Leonardo da Vinci, masterclasses and collaboration with the "Ars Nova" International Competition.
